

# LAW 7159: Civ & Crim Health Care Fraud

Each year, tens of billions of dollars are lost to health care provider fraud and abuse in the US. Fear of prosecution pervades the industry and shapes business decisions. Students in this course study the many laws that place health care providers at risk of criminal prosecution and civil penalties, including the False Claims Act, the Medicare/Medicaid Anti-Kickback Act, HIPAA, the Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act, antitrust law, securities law, the Stark Law, as well as numerous criminal statutes that are applicable to health care. Students explore civil, criminal and administrative remedies from the perspective of prosecutor, defense counsel, corporate counsel, compliance counsel and regulator. Exam Info: Take-Home Exam
